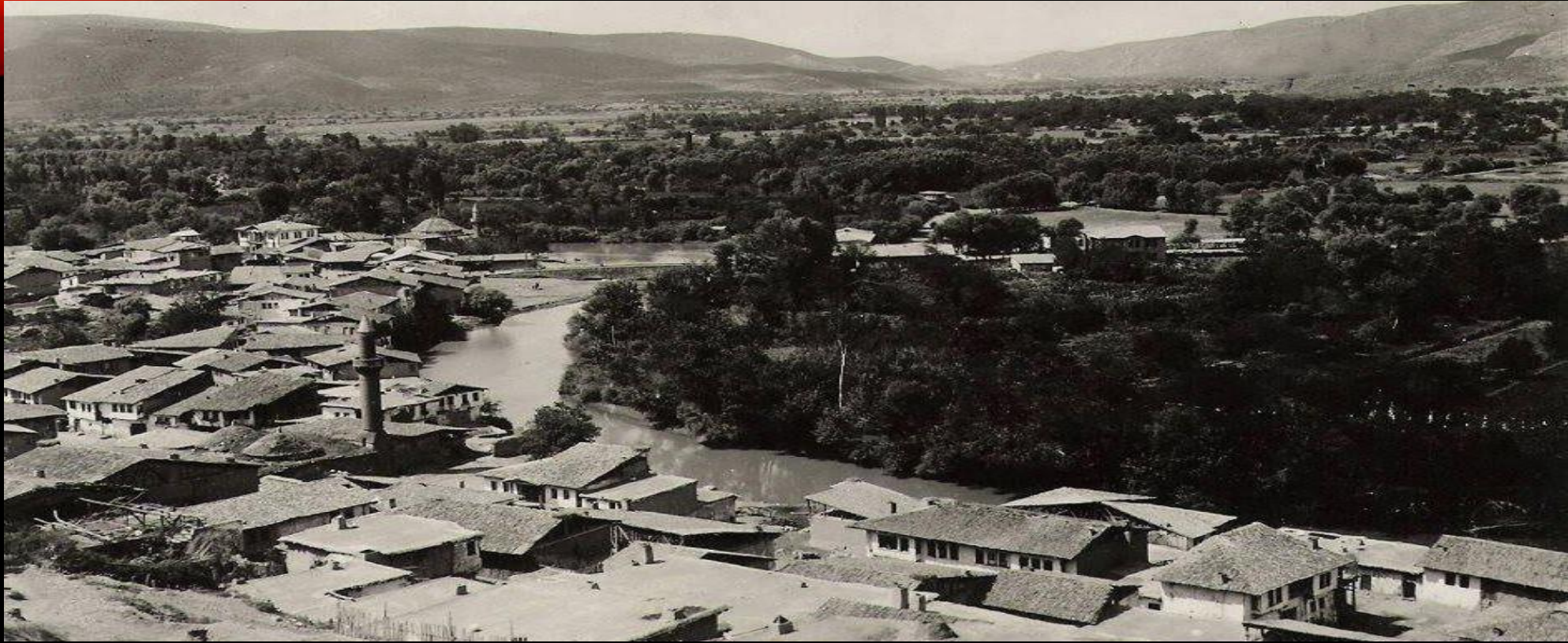


TOKAT
