

ANTALYA


- Antalya is a touristic destination in south of Turkey. Every year, a lot of tourists come to Antalya for holiday.





- The caves and underground cities




TROY

NOAH'S ARK


- Some explorers claim that Noah's Ark landed on Mount Ararat in Turkey
